Questions

1. God gives us everything we REALLY need – air to breathe, food to eat, shelter, sunshine, rain, etc. etc. for our *physical* bodies, but most importantly, He provides salvation for our *spiritual* bodies in Christ.
2. God has given us our families as well as many others. Our parents care for us and teach us about God. We also have pastors, elders, deacons, Sunday school teachers and regular teachers who all help us.

3. Gospel
