Teaching Notes

Pray & Review Q9: What is God? – *God is a spirit and has not a body like men.*

Story from 1 Kings 8:27; Solomon's building the Temple. God doesn't live in any church...it couldn't hold Him!

Questions

1. **No. He is everywhere.** Ps 139:7-16, Job 11:7-9, Acts 17:24, 28 - Is He here with us? **Yes.** Does He see what we're doing? **Yes.** Should this affect the way we live? **Yes!** (Of course, He doesn't need to see us to know what we are doing, since He knows what we will do from all eternity. Ps 139:16)
2. **Yes.** Ps 139:8 – He is the fire that burns in hell – it is His wrath against sinners. God's presence is a blessing for this in heaven, but it is a curse for those in hell.
(*Decide how much of this to share with them*).
3. **He is so great, so (infinitely) big.**
He is every bit as much here as He is in China, Mars, the Sun, or even the far side of the universe. Psalm 139
Refer to last week's verse.

"*Omnipresent*" = 'all present' = Everywhere

Gospel – Since God is everywhere and sees all we do, He also knows all the wrong things we've done and are doing (sins) and will punish us for those wrong things in hell. He also promises to forgive us for all our sins and to save us from hell, if we will turn from our sins and trust in Jesus. Since God is everywhere, He will hear us where ever we are if we will pray to Him and ask Him for His mercy and forgiveness.
