Teaching Notes

Pray & Review Q7. In how many Persons does this one God exist? - In three Persons.

How many Gods are there? One. How many persons? Three
What is the special word that means "three-in-one"? *Trinity = tri-unity.*

Review: Emphasize that this one God exists in *three persons*. All are fully God (Rom. 1:7 Father is God; John 1:1; - Jesus is God - Rom. 9:5; Acts 5:3-4 Spirit is God) and are to be worshiped and obeyed. These three persons are obviously not the same person (see discussion of their work below – they cannot be the same person and have the relationships they have with each other). To believe that they are is another serious problem that leads some to worship a false god, e.g., the Apostolic Church, the United Pentecostal Church, who believe that Jesus is the only person in the Godhead.

Questions

1. What's the first person of the Trinity called and why?

The Father is called the Father because He is the Father of the Son (He begets the Son; use John 1:14; 3:16 to show that God is the begetter and Jesus is the begotten).

2. What's the second person of the Trinity called and why?

The Son is called the Son because He is the Son of the Father (eternally begotten of the Father).

3. What's the third person of the Trinity called and why?

The Spirit is called the Spirit because He proceeds from the Father and the Son (breathed out: breath is one of the meanings of the word 'Spirit'. Use John 15:26 to show that He proceeds from the Father and Galatians 4:6 to show that He has a similar relationship with the Son).

Gospel: Only the true God can save us. Do you believe in the Triune God?

Extras: Read the Nicene Creed.
