### **Teaching Notes.**

Review 51: What is sanctification? - *It is God's making sinners holy in heart and conduct.*

**Story:** John 10 The Good Shepherd

### Questions

1. He agreed to become a man: (Heb. 2:14). He agreed to obey for God's elect: (John 17:19). He agreed to die for God's elect: (John 10:15). He agreed to intercede for God's elect. (Isa. 53:12). (John 17:9). (1 John 2:1).

(In most of these verses, it's clear Jesus does these things for the elect.)

2. For those whom the Father had given Him: the elect. (John 10:14-15). (2 Tim. 2:10). Jesus took the place of the elect in His life, death, resurrection, ascension and glorification. He did everything necessary to save them.

3. No one can look into God's Book of Life (Rev. 20:12, 15). But everyone can look into their own heart to see if they love God and are trusting Jesus to save them (2 Cor. 13:5; 2 Pet. 1:10-11).

Jesus said He came to save those who would believe in Him: “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life” (John 3:16).

Gospel: Do you believe in Jesus? Are you trusting in Him to save you? Remember that you are guilty of Adam's sin (Rom. 5:12, 18). You are guilty of many sins of your own. One sin is enough to send you to hell forever. But God sent His Son to obey and die for sinners, so that they might not perish. “He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him” (2 Cor. 5:21). If you will trust in Jesus this morning, God will forgive your sins and give you eternal life. Come to Jesus; He will never turn you away: “All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out” (John 6:37).
