### Questions

1. The word in the Bible means "the right to control or govern over." Webster gives this definition: "Legal power, or a right to command or to act; as the authority of a prince over subjects, and of parents over children. Power; rule; sway."

Authority is *the power to command others to do something within the bounds or limits of that authority.*

2. *It comes from God.*

"Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God" (Rom. 13:1).

"It is He who changes the times and the epochs; He removes kings and establishes kings; He gives wisdom to wise men and knowledge to men of understanding" (Dan. 2:21).

Gospel: Your willingness to submit to your parents, to your teachers, and to your elders has a lot to say about your willingness to submit to the Lord. Do you honor the authority God has ordained, especially that of your parents? *There is a promise attached to your obedience to this command, "That it may be well with you, and that you may live long on the earth" (Eph. 6:3).* If you do this from your heart, because you love the Lord Jesus, there is a promise attached to this as well: the Lord will prepare a place for you in heaven (John 14:2-3). Make sure that you are trusting in the Lord and obeying Him in all His commandments from your heart.
