Review: Q91. What is the fifth commandment? - *Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the Lord your God gives you.*

Scripture: Matt. 21:28-32 - The parable of the two sons in the vineyard.

Questions

3. He has established authority *in the home:*

Of husbands over wives (Eph. 5:22-24).

Of parents over children (Eph. 6:1-3).

He has established authority *in the state.* (Rom. 13:1, 1 Pet. 2:13-15).

He has established authority *in the church.* (1 Pet. 5:1-2, Heb. 13:17).

He has established the authority *of the master* over the servant.

When you agree to work for someone, you become their servant and are under their authority for a time. (Eph. 6:5-6).

He has established the authority *of the teacher* over the student.

When you sit under a teacher and become their disciple, you must honor and submit to them as well. (Matt. 10:24-25).

4. You must honor those in authority by submitting to them.

Are there any limits to that submission? - Yes. If they tell us to do anything contrary to God's Word, we must not obey. (Acts 5:27-29).

Gospel: (*Repeat of last week*) Your willingness to submit to your parents, to your teachers, and to your elders has a lot to say about your willingness to submit to the Lord. Do you honor the authority God has ordained, especially that of your parents? There is a promise attached to your obedience to this command, "That it may be well with you, and that you may live long on the earth" (Eph. 6:3). If you do this from your heart, because you love the Lord Jesus, there is a promise attached to this as well: the Lord will prepare a place for you in heaven (John 14:2-3). Make sure that you are trusting in the Lord and obeying Him in all His commandments from your heart.
