Scripture: Matthew 28 and/or Acts 1:1-11

Questions

1. It is the kingdom over which He is Lord, which includes the whole world (Ps. 24:1). More narrowly, it refers to those who have savingly believed and embraced the Gospel (the church; John 3:3, 5).
2. Only through the Gospel. Only those who hear the Gospel, believe it, and trust in Christ, will enter into His redemptive Kingdom and be saved (Acts 16:31).
3. We are asking that the Lord would:
 - raise up more workers to preach the Gospel (Matt 9:37-38)
 - equip them with truth and provide the means for them to go to other countries (even to this country) to preach. In other words, we are praying that the Great Commission would be fulfilled (Matt. 28:18-20).
 - grant the awakening influence of His Holy Spirit, to open the eyes of unbelievers to their sins and danger. That they would be afraid of the Lord’s judgment and obey Him.
 - bring more people into His invisible church; that He would change stony hearts and open blind eyes so that many would trust in Jesus and be saved.

Gospel: Where are you in God’s kingdom? Are you like those in the world who don’t believe the Gospel? Do you believe the Gospel, but haven’t yet trusted in Christ? Or have you genuinely trusted Jesus to save you and show that you have by obeying Him? Only those who trust in Jesus will go to heaven to be with Him. Those who won’t trust Him will suffer forever for their sins. If you haven’t trusted Him, pray and ask Him to give you His Spirit so that you can.
